




## Overall Perception of School Quality

## AAPS 'Arts Advantage'


- 100% of AAPS elementary students receive 60 minutes of art and 60 minutes of music weekly.
- 60% of Middle School students are enrolled in visual art classes and 72% in music classes.








#### **High School Students**



#### 2016 SAT Mean Score











#### 2016 Graduation Rates










#### 2016 Graduation Rates

**6-Year Trend** 






#### Student Enrollment Comparison

Fall Count and Percentage Change from the Previous Years Ended June 30






#### AAPS Foundation Grant Trend Not Adjusted for Inflation






#### **AAPS Foundation Grant Trend**
